## Vote Early

## Vote by Mail

You can request an absentee ballot to be mailed to you at [MyVote.WI.gov/Vote-Absentee-By-Mail](https://MyVote.WI.gov/Vote-Absentee-By-Mail). Mail back your absentee ballot by March 28 or personally deliver it to your municipal clerk by 8 p.m. on Election Day.
