

IDs for VOTING



APPROVED WISCONSIN PHOTO IDS FOR VOTING



- **Wisconsin Driver's License** — Current or expired since November 6, 2018.
- **Wisconsin State ID Card** — Current or expired since November 6, 2018.
- **Military ID** — Current, expired since November 6, 2018, or with no expiration date.
- **US Passport** — Current or expired since November 6, 2018.
- **Veteran Affairs Card** — Unexpired, or have no expiration date.
- **Wisconsin Tribal ID** — Current or expired.
- **Certificate of Naturalization** — Must be issued within two years of voting day.
- **Student ID from Wisconsin Accredited College** — Must be signed and have issuance date and expiration within two years of issuance. Also bring proof of enrollment.
- **ID, Driver's License, or and IDPP Receipt from DMV** — Must be unexpired.



Use your Wisconsin ID or driver's license to register to vote at **MYVOTE.WI.GOV** up to 20 days before each election – but you can also register on Election Day at the polls!
